Notes:

- (1) Bayswater competed in the WAAFL and was different to the Bayswater ⁽²⁾ club that competed in the WAFA
- (2) Central Districts ⁽⁷⁾ and Mt Lawley (WAFA) merged to form Bayswater-Mt Lawley in 1962 and later changed name to Bayswater in 1963
- (3) Belmont was different to the Belmont ⁽¹⁴⁾ club that competed from 1981 onwards
- (4) Belmont ⁽³⁾ and Victoria Park merged to form Belmont-Victoria Park in 1969 and split into separate clubs again in 1972.
- (5) Cockburn ⁽¹¹⁾ and East Fremantle ⁽⁸⁾ merged to form Cockburn-East Fremantle in 1967. The latter part of the name was dropped to become Cockburn in 1977
- (6) Commonwealth Bank changed name to Banks in 1939 and back to Commonwealth Bank in 1951.
- (7) Daily News changed name to Central Districts in 1961.
- (8) East Fremantle was different to the East Fremantle ⁽⁹⁾ club that competed in the WAAFL
- (9) East Fremantle merged with Cockburn to form Cockburn-East Fremantle ⁽⁵⁾ in 1967
- (10) Fremantle were previously known as North Fremantle (Ex-Scholars) until 1980, and was different to the North Fremantle Amateurs club that competesa in the WAAFL
- (11) Fremantle changed name to Cockburn in 1958. Cockburn later merged with East Fremantle ⁽⁶⁾ in 1967.
- (12) Inglewood was different to the Inglewood ⁽¹⁶⁾ club that competed in the WAAFL in the 1950s
- (13) Inglewood ⁽¹²⁾ and Bayswater ⁽²⁾ merged into Inglewood-Bayswater in 1972. The latter part of the name was dropped to become Inglewood in 1979
- (14) Metropolitans (formerly Sunday Times) and Victoria Park merged to form Metropolitans-Victoria Park in 1980, and later changed name to Belmont in 1981.
- (15) Midland Junction changed name to Midland in 1960.
- (16) Mt Lawley changed name to Inglewood-Mt Lawley in 1949, then to Inglewood in 1951. This club is different to the Mt Lawley club that entered the WAAFL in 1963.
- (17) Palmyra changed name to Melville in 1958, then to East Fremantle-Palmyra in 1961, then to East Fremantle in 1963, then to Palmyra in 1964 and back to Melville in 1968
- (18) Scarborough was different to the Scarborough club that competed in the WAAFL from 1972 onwards
- (19) South Perth changed name to Victoria Park-South Perth in 1997
